“A relative latecomer, Roderick Lewis only picked up a digital SLR for the first time in 2005, when his interest in photography was sparked whilst on holiday in a very beautiful part of Italy. The experience made him look at his surroundings in a very different way, and he soon discovered that there is some amazing coastal scenery right on his doorstep, and so began a passionate career in landscape and seascape photography.

In the last year Roderick has held two solo exhibitions, with two more to follow. He has also exhibited work at the National Theatre as part of The AA Landscape Photographer of the Year, for which he was shortlisted, and his image can be seen in the 2008 AA Landscape Photographer of the Year book. He is also a regular contributor to the british magazine “*Digital Photographer*”.

October 2008 saw a very successful trip to Utah and Arizona for Roderick, yeilding many stunning images. A selection of these, along with coastal and landscape scenes from Dorset and Cornwall in the UK, and portraits from The Gambia, Africa, will form the main body of Roderick’s August exhibition here at Art Place 88.
